ARIZONA SCHOOL LETTER GRADES RELEASED!

We are proud to announce that Palo Verde earned a rating of 'B'! Way to be 212° and go the extra degree!

Arizona's first post-pandemic scorecard of school performance is out. School letter grades are a calculation of how schools are performing on a series of measures, including state test scores, that families can use to compare schools. The 2021-2022 school year grades, released this month by the Arizona State Board of Education, rely on spring 2022 test data. Our improved grade shows the hard work that we have done despite the disturbances from COVID-19.

Letter grades are mandated by state law. Federal law also requires states to measure school performance using comparable measures across schools. A letter grade is a snapshot of assessment test scores, student learning growth from year to year, the preparation level of middle and elementary school students for the next grade and high school graduation rates.

The school letter grades are intended to give parents and the community a way to judge how schools are performing.
