The Ecology Club is hosting a Garden Clean Up Friday, October 21st after school. They'll be working on cleaning up the pond area so that they can restore the area (with advice from a restoration expert at Tucson Audubon Society). They will also be trimming, weeding, and raking over on the garden side, and preparing the planters for winter seeds. Some UA students and a couple of volunteers from the Tucson Audubon Society will be coming to help in the cleaning process.

Students can earn community service hours for their efforts. And, of course, we'd love it if YOU would like to stay and lend a hand as well. Many hands make light work as they say!

The Tucson Audubon Society is coming to PV for 4 visits. They will be teaching the Ecology Club about how birds impact our ecosystem, invasive species, and the participants will be building nesting boxes for Lucy's warblers (a bird that is losing its habitat due to development).

PV is partnering with U of A Fish and Wildlife to restore the Wetlands area (the best we can). A guest from Tucson Gardens is coming out to teach the kids how native farmers have been planting and growing in the desert for hundreds of years.
