The Ecology Club is hosting a Garden Clean Up Friday, October 21<sup>st</sup> after school. Some UA students and a couple of volunteers from the Tucson Audubon Society will be coming to help in the cleaning process.

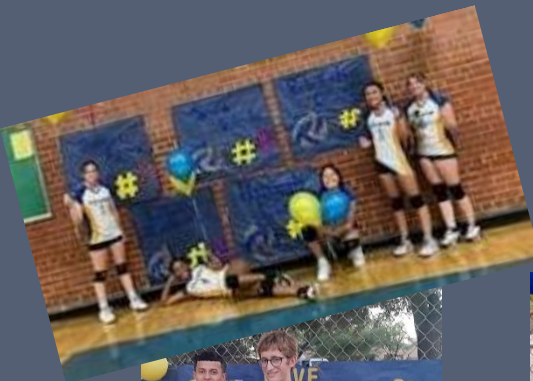

**Pima Community College East Campus TRiO Upward Bound**

**Program History**  
Upward Bound (UB) is a TRiO program federally funded by the U.S. Department of Education. The first TRiO programs were created in 1964 under the Economic Opportunity Act. Today there are eight TRiO programs, which assist economically and educationally disadvantaged students in preparing, enrolling, and successfully completing postsecondary education.

**Program Eligibility**

- 2/3 of participating students served are low-income and first-generation
- Students served need to be enrolled at participating high schools
- Students must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Students must be US citizens or permanent residents

UB at PCC-East campus began providing services in 2000. Today the program is funded to serve 65 students enrolled at Palo Verde and Santa Rita high schools.

\* Funding for the TRiO Upward Bound (UB) Program is provided by the US Department of Education and requires specific documentation enrollment into the Program. The information is protected by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).

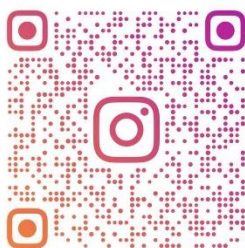
