**Program History**  
 Upward Bound (UB) is a TRiO program federally funded by the U.S. Department of Education. The first TRiO programs were created in 1964 under the Economic Opportunity Act. Today there are eight TRiO programs, which assist economically and educationally disadvantaged students in preparing, enrolling, and successfully completing postsecondary education.

UB at PCC-East campus began providing services in 2000. Today the program is funded to serve 65 students enrolled at Palo Verde and Santa Rita high schools.

**Program Eligibility**

- 2/3 of participating students served are low-income and first-generation
- Students served need to be enrolled at participating high schools
- Students must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Students must be US citizens or permanent residents
